You are kindly invited to submit abstracts with a focus on the following fields:

- 1. Language, world, experience: general principles and theoretical concepts
- 2. Teaching Chinese online: experiences and reflections
- 3. Online Learning Modules, E-learning courses, multimedia formats innovative ideas for teaching and learning in the field of TCFL
- 4. Images travel, travel broadens the mind: China on the web and in real (including student exchanges)
- 5. Literature, fantasy and science fiction as concepts of teaching and learning
- 6. Level descriptions, performance assessment, examinations
- 7. Chinese between standard and variance
- 8. Chinese for preschool and primary school children
- 9. Chinese as a foreign language in secondary schools and as a subject at German Abitur level
- 10. Teacher education and further training of teachers
- 11. Chinese as an academic language
- 12. Chinese as a professional language at workplace
- 13. Translating and interpreting Chinese today

Submission guidelines:

Conference languages are German, Chinese and English. Your abstract should be written in the language of your oral presentation and should not exceed 400 words (or about 600 Chinese characters), excluding references..

Abstracts are to be submitted via EasyChair (https://easychair.org/conferences/?conf=fach2022).

Presentations should be 25 minutes long (plus 5 minutes Q&A); workshops 90 minutes at a maximum; workshops 90 minutes at a maximum.

Written versions of the complete papers are not required. Written papers can be submitted for publication in *CHUN* – *Chinesischunterricht* after the conference. There will be a separate review and selection of papers prior to publication.

Deadline for submission of abstracts: 31 January 2022.

You will be notified about the acceptance of abstracts by 31 March 2022.
